A WASA mentor is available to answer questions as you plan your artwork  
especially with regard to your selection of subject matter. (point 3 below)

#### Conditions of entry

1. The artist does not need to be a member of WASA.
2. Each artist may enter up to 2 artworks. The artworks may be 2 or 3 dimensional pieces.
3. Your artwork needs to feature wildlife – **no domestic animals** ( eg: no domestic/pet dogs, cats, horses, rabbits). Please work from your own photographs/sketches or if another person's photo you need to have permission to use it and this includes images from the internet.
4. Artworks need to be **framed with hanging wire** attached to the rear **OR matted and wrapped** in clear quality plastic as per image below (matts to be white or off-white colour). **Unframed wired gallery-wrap canvas** is acceptable. Please include a **label on the reverse** of your 2 and 3-d artworks with your name , the title and your age when you created the piece.
5. Artworks can be for sale and 20% sales commission will be charged.
6. Maximum framed size is 1 metre wide.
7. **Entries close 14<sup>th</sup> June 2019** – lodge your entry form by email or post.
8. Artworks to be **delivered** to AGRA Galleries between 25<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> June 1pm-4pm or by arrangement to Kris Peter in Box Hill - ph to arrange suitable day/time 0412 104 825  
Artworks need to be **collected** on Sunday July 14<sup>th</sup> between 1 and 4pm from AGRA Galleries.
9. **Cost to enter \$5 per artwork** – direct payment to WASA account, BSB 633000 account 152552865 or cheque by post payable to Wildlife Art Society of Australasia, P O Box 284, Canterbury 3126
10. WASA may use photos of your artwork and people visiting the gallery for promotional purposes.
11. **Maximum number of artworks accepted is 170.\*** WASA reserves the right to swap artworks ½ way through the exhibition to allow all to be shown for at least one week if maximum numbers are submitted.
12. 2-d artworks must not contain any natural animal items such as feathers, fur, plant life, shells etc.

If you can email an image of your artwork/s by early June we may use it in publicity for the event.
